

PRIVACY POLICY

Under The General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) dated 25th May, 2018, we set out below how Atelier82 ('we') use and protect any information that you give us when you use this website or deal with us. We are committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide certain information by which you can be identified when using this website, then you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy policy.

What we collect

We may collect the following information:

- name and job title
- contact information including email address and telephone number(s)
- demographic information such as postcode and type of organisation
- details of your visits to our website such as traffic data, and the resources that you access.

We will collect information about your computer, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type and for system administration. This is statistical data about our users' browsing actions and patterns and does not identify any individual.

We also collect information through 'cookies' - see "How we use cookies" below for further details.

What we do with the information we gather

We require this information to understand your needs and provide you with a better service, and in particular for the following reasons:-

Where we store your personal data

How we use cookies

Our website uses normal https 'session' cookies, the lifetime of these is that they expire instantly the browser is closed, their purpose is to identify logged on users only.

We may obtain information about your general internet usage by using a cookie file which is stored on your browser or the hard drive of your computer. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. They help us to improve our website and to deliver a better and more personalised service. Some of the cookies we use are essential for the website to operate. Cookies are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the website. Cookies can help analyse web traffic or let us know when you visit our site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual.
